Frequently Asked Questions

How can I book with you?

- The easiest way is to book directly at our own website. In addition, if you book directly with us, you will receive a bottle of sparkling wine on arrival.

I see no availability at all in July and August on various booking sites. Is that right?

- Indeed, in July and August you can only book directly with us. Booking sites charge a significant part of the total booking sum, and this is not profitable for us in the summer.

Can we bring the dog?

- Your dog is very welcome with us. We do ask you to report this in advance, so that we can close our dog gates between the houses before your arrival. You are of course responsible for any damage. We also ask you, when you walk your dog, to do this in the direction of the forest, and not into the village - otherwise all the farm dogs will start barking and this will cause a lot of unwanted unrest in the village.

Are the gardens around the houses hermetically sealed?

- No, only the Middle House offers your dog no escape option. The other gardens are partially open.

Can I also come with a large group?

- Our accommodation is very suitable for larger groups, because the houses are located next to each other and are connected through the gardens. In principle, each house accommodates 6 guests, whereby an additional bed can be placed in each house. In addition, we can place a baby cot (plus high chair) in every house.

Do we need to bring bed linen and towels?

- No, we make the beds for you and provide towels. In the summer you will also receive beach towels from us. We expect you to bring your own toiletries.

What kind of coffee machine is in the houses?

- You have access to a standard filter device. In the kitchen we prepare a starter stock of filters, size 4.

I would like to cook extensively, is the kitchen in the holiday homes sufficiently equipped?

- The kitchens in our houses are very elaborately equipped. Here you will find a complete inventory.

Do we have to bring wood and charcoal for the outdoor kitchen?

- No, we provide wood, coal and firelighters for you. If you have big plans, please bring extra charcoal.

What does that mean, a natural swimming pool?

- Our swimming pool is cleaned in an organic, bacteriological way. So no chemicals are used. This means that there is always some algae formation. This is completely harmless. Our water meets the highest quality requirements and is regularly tested in a laboratory. Before you book with us, keep in mind that a natural pool is not the same as a chlorine pool!

Why is the colour of the pool green in the photos?

- We opted for a green foil because it fits better in the environment. The water itself is colourless.

Is the pool heated?

- The pool is not heated: In late spring the water temperature is about 22 degrees, in a warm summer period 25/26 degrees.

Can I also stay shorter than five days in the summer months?

- In the summer months the minimum stay with us is five days. However, it is possible that a few days remain between the different bookings. You can then book these, with a minimum of two nights.

Do the houses have air conditioning?

- No, our houses do not have AC. The houses are maximally insulated and have a pleasant temperature, even in summer. However, it is important to ventilate well at night and to keep the windows and doors closed during the day.

I would like to come in the winter months. How are the houses heated?

- In the colder months, the houses are heated with the large central stove in the living room. This also (indirectly) heats the bedrooms, but keep in mind that the temperature in the bedrooms does not exceed about 20 degrees Celsius. The bathrooms are heated with infrared panels.

We would like to book full board, is that possible?

- We do not provide meals. Lunch and dinner can be ordered in the village. When you book with us, we will send you the menu options. It is not possible to order breakfast, but we do offer you the opportunity to reserve a shopping basket with us. This contains snacks and ingredients for your first breakfast in Irota.

Are the houses wheelchair accessible?

- The ground floor of each house is wheelchair accessible. Each house has a wheelchair-friendly bathroom, with a wider door, support brackets, adjustable washbasin mirror and a seat in the shower. The Lower House has a garden on the same level as the terrace, so that

the garden is also accessible via the terrace, and the jetty to the swimming pool via the garden.

I would like to check out later than 10am, or arrive earlier than 2pm. Is that possible?

- We do our utmost to be flexible with arrival and departure times. In the summer months, however, it often happens that our guests arrive and depart on the same day. In that case, we really need the time between 10 am and 2 pm to prepare the house in question for the arriving guests and we can therefore not offer a later check-out or earlier check-in.

What about WiFi and mobile coverage in the Lodges?

- Your house and also the terrace have WiFi (no code required). Mobile coverage is also available, but this is quite weak for Hungarian numbers starting with 20 or 70. The houses also have a 'landline' telephone line, which works via the internet and is free to use.

Are there mosquito nets on the windows?

- All windows are fitted with mosquito nets. However, the doors are not, so in the warm summer months we recommend that you keep the windows open and the doors closed at night.

Can we celebrate our wedding at Irota EcoLodge?

- No, unfortunately, such events cannot be held with us. We explicitly rent out holiday homes, not a party location.
